

# NFL HALL OF FAME QUARTERBACK BRETT FAVRE

Brett Lorenzo Favre was born in Gulfport, Mississippi, and raised in the small town of Kiln, Mississippi. He is the second of four children and attended Hancock North Central High School where he played baseball and football.

Upon graduation, Favre received a scholarship from the University of Southern Mississippi. He began his freshman year as the seventh-string quarterback and took over the starting position in the second half of the third game of the year.

Favre began his career in the NFL when he was drafted by the Atlanta Falcons in the second round, 33rd overall in the 1991 NFL Draft.

In 1992, he was traded to the Green Bay Packers and played 16 seasons with the team. During his career with Green Bay, Favre was the first NFL player to win three consecutive AP MVP awards. He also helped the Packers appear in two Super Bowls, winning Super Bowl XXXI.

On August 7, 2008 the Packers traded Favre to the New York Jets. In week four, he threw six touchdowns against the Arizona Cardinals, a personal best and one fewer than the NFL record.

On August 18, 2009, Favre signed with the Minnesota Vikings. During Week 2, Favre surpassed former Vikings defensive end Jim Marshall for consecutive starts at one position, with 291. On October 5, with a 30-23 victory over his former team (Green Bay Packers), Favre became the first quarterback in NFL history to defeat every one of the league's 32 franchises since the NFL first expanded to 32 teams in 2002. This Monday night game between Minnesota and Green Bay was the most-viewed television program, sports or otherwise, in the history of cable television.

Over his career Favre set many records and milestones and won numerous awards and honors. In 2016 he was inducted into the NFL Hall of Fame.
